



ALSO Provider Course Sponsor Fact Sheet

Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO[®]) is an evidence-based multidisciplinary training program that prepares maternity health care providers to better manage obstetric emergencies.

ALSO Program Curriculum: This evidence-based curriculum is incorporated through hands-on workshops, mnemonics and case-based discussions. Participants are encouraged to complete the pre-course online self-assessment.

ALSO Audience: The ALSO program was developed for all maternity care providers, including physicians, nurses, nurse midwives, and other clinicians.

Expenses: The only expense is to purchase ALSO materials. Payment expected within thirty days of receipt of the invoice. Below is a listing of the available materials.

Faculty: The course faculty must consist of the following:

Role	Responsibility
Advisory Faculty (AF)	Available to assist the course director in all aspects in the planning and development of the course. Must have AF status as of course date and be onsite during the entire course.
Course Director	Oversee and manage all aspects of implementing the course. Must have current ALSO Provider or Approved Instructor (recommended) status.
ALSO Approved Instructors	At least fifty percent of the faculty must be ALSO Approved Instructors or Instructor Candidates. ALSO Staff will assist in finding faculty if needed.
Other Instructors	Individuals may include qualified healthcare professionals who are comfortable with the goals and objectives of the course and agree to use standard course methods.

ALSO Status: After a participant has completed and passed the course, they will have a five-year ALSO provider status. If they wish to maintain this status, they must attend another ALSO Provider, Refresher or Instructor course before their five-year expiration/renewal date. Participants receive a course completion certificate and wallet card, after the post-course materials are submitted to ALSO program staff.

CME/CNE: CME credit is awarded to all attendees by the AAFP. CNE credit is awarded to nurse participants by the KSBN, pending submission of the Nurse Roster within one week of the course.
