<i>Early</i>	Establishing a Nationwide Sugar-Sweetened Beverage Tax to Combat Obesity and Comorbidities RESOLVED, that the AAFP release a statement endorsing a nationwide sugar-sweetened beverage tax as a measure that would improve the the health of all Americans.
<i>Early</i>	Resolution to Support Reproductive Health Education RESOLVED, that the American Academy of Family Physicians advocate on behalf of family physicians who perform and teach contraception, options counseling for unintended pregnancy, miscarriage management, and abortion care, many of whom are subjected to legislation or hospital restrictions that may limit scope of practice or training opportunities, and be it further RESOLVED, that planners of the American Academy of Family Physicians National Conference of Residents and Students support and encourage inclusion of reproductive health topics such as contraception, abortion, miscarriage, and options counseling for unintended pregnancy, as well as procedural topics like intrauterine device insertion and implant insertion at National Conference.
