Delivery of Medical Aid

One of the primary responsibilities of the Physicians With Heart delegation is to document the safe arrival of the donated pharmaceuticals, medical instruments and supplies. The cargo plane, provided by the U.S. State Department, will arrive before the delegation, and in cooperation with the Ministry of Health, pallets of medical aid will be transported to recipient hospitals and clinics throughout Tajikistan. The delegation plays a key role in visiting several of these recipient hospitals and clinics to verify the arrival and secure storage of the donations. Heart to Heart representatives conduct extensive follow-up after the conclusion of the project to ensure that the distribution is complete.

ALSO

Physicians With Heart will conduct Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO®) courses by presenting two Provider Courses and one Instructor Course over a five-day period. ALSO equips maternity-care providers with skills and systemized responses to obstetrical emergencies. The ALSO courses will be presented in a hands-on, "train-the-trainers" format so that Tajik physicians will come away from the five days of training with the ability to replicate the program throughout the country. In order to participate in the ALSO training, a delegate must be currently an approved ALSO Advisory Faculty.

Family Medicine Symposia

A major and increasing element of Physicians With Heart is fostering the development of Family Medicine worldwide. During our projects, we present the specialty at large medical schools and in small roundtable discussions. We also conduct pharmaceutical-update sessions regarding the donated medicines we bring. Lectures may be presented on clinical topics, the structure and function of Family Medicine in the U.S. and worldwide, and a typical day in the life of an American family physician.

The Children's Project

The Children's Project provides assistance to vulnerable children at schools and orphanages in Tajikistan. We work with local organizations to identify the most needy institutions and provide follow-up after the project is completed. This year's project will benefit the Dushanbe Day Care for the Disabled and the Vakhsh District Boarding School. The Dushanbe Day Care provides a nurturing and educational daytime environment for 82 physically disabled children and 11 blind children that are affected by muscular dystrophy and cerebral palsy, as well as other ailments. It is the only institution of its type in Tajikistan. Vakhsh District Boarding School was established for orphans of the Tajik civil war that ended in 1993. It stills provides housing and education to 276 needy children from the southern part of Tajikistan.
