This award recognizes family medicine residents and medical students who demonstrate leadership ability. The \$600 scholarship is intended to help reduce out-of-pocket expenses (registration, travel, lodging, meals) to attend National Conference.

Eligibility:

A member of the American Academy of Family Physicians
In good standing at your program/school
Must not be receiving other funding to attend

Rules and Regulations:

Application and supporting documents must be received via fax, e-mail or postmarked no later than May 1. Winners will be selected by a panel of judges and notified on May 31. You may only apply for one NC scholarship award annually. Scholarships will be awarded on site. If you are unable to attend the conference, your scholarship will be forfeited.

REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION:

1. Current CV
2. 500-word essay on how you will use your leadership skills to address challenges and opportunities facing family physicians
3. Recommendation letter from a chapter officer or executive
4. Recommendation letter from the residency director, medical school dean, or faculty advisor
