AAFP-PT is pleased to offer the least expensive quality assurance program in the country for the Waived and PPM laboratories. Although Waived laboratories are not required by CLIA '88 to perform proficiency testing, some states and accreditation agencies encourage these laboratories to participate in a Quality Assurance program. Labs receive one sample two times per year, in April and November, along with the answer key to grade their own performance. The answer key includes the peer group acceptable results for your quality assurance check of the samples ordered. AAFP-PT's program also offers up to 12 hours of continuing education.
