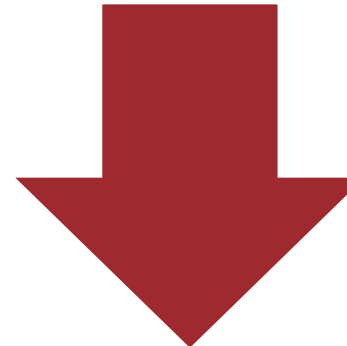

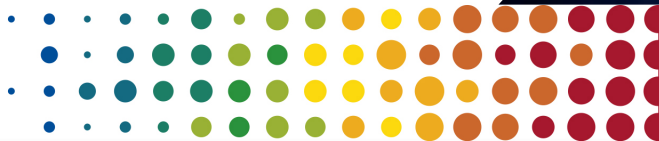

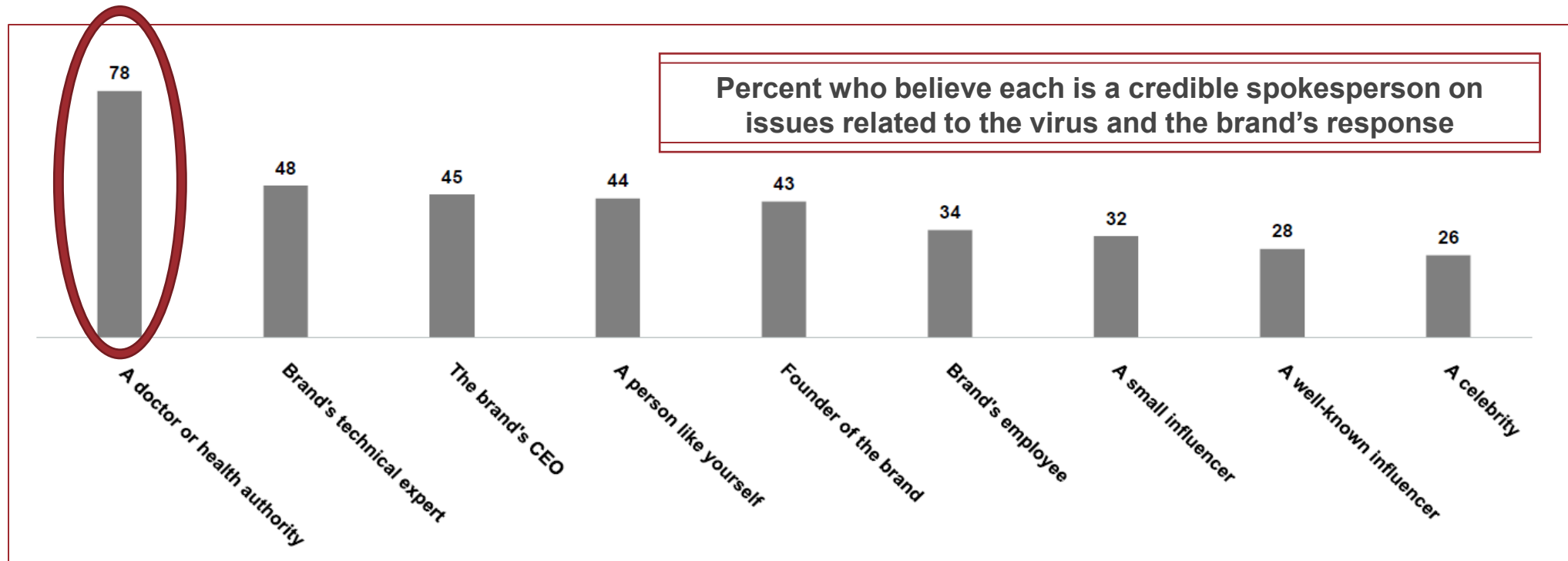

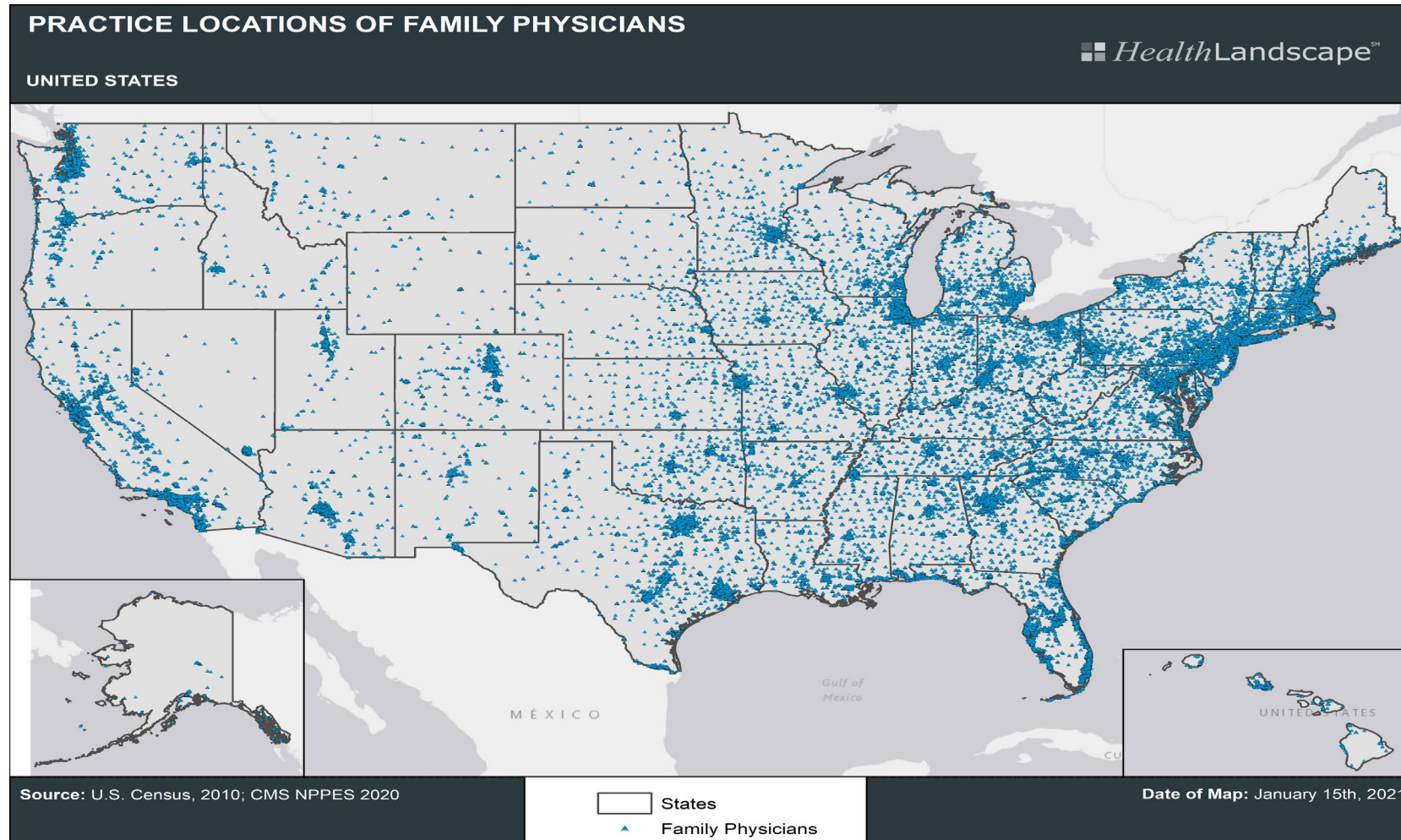


Who do consumers trust most on issues related to health or COVID-19?

Family Physicians are Everywhere & Provide Care to Millions of Patients



Over 95% of US counties have at least one family physician.

This geographic distribution of family physicians is not matched by any other physician specialty.

Immediate Access to Vaccines for Family Physicians

Many Family Physicians have struggled to access the COVID-19 vaccine for themselves and their care teams. It is imperative that all frontline healthcare workers get vaccinated, especially Family Physicians and their care teams.

AAFP Geospatial Data Visualization Tool that can Help Target Vaccine Resources & Efforts

- *Population Health Mapper* includes Health Outcome and Health Determinant Metrics to identify populations in highest need.
- The HealthLandscape tool allows for the visualization of data and health care trends at the county level, giving users insight into potential areas of focus.
- By mapping vaccination rates from previous influenza seasons, we can better understand where efforts to vaccinate were most successful and, similarly, where they fell short.



Hot-spotting and Cold-spotting

- The map shows family physician practice locations by county, illustrating where these primary care providers could quickly and efficiently be deployed to increase rapid population vaccination. Pharmacy locations and other relevant data can be added to enhance the narrative.
- This “hot-spotting” and “cold-spotting” exploration could yield important information for targeting immunization efforts, resources, and educational outreach to specific geographic regions based on previous trends.

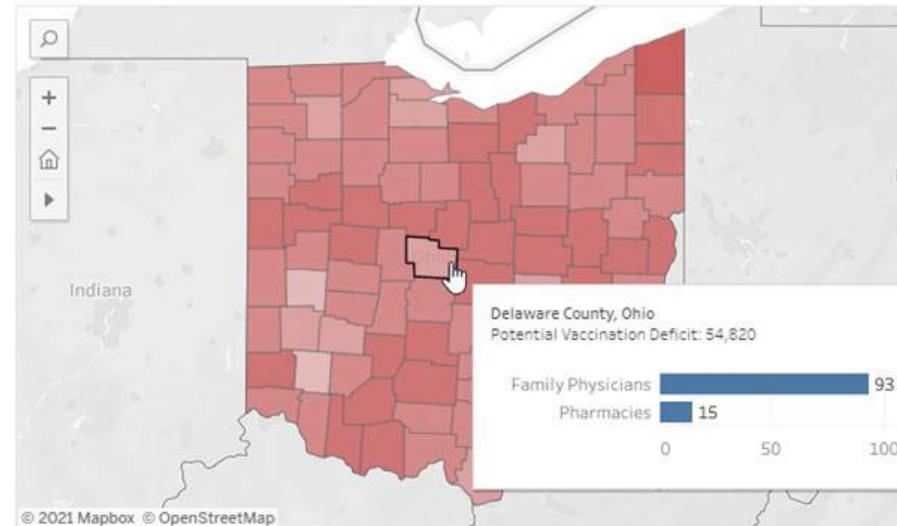
The **Vaccination Deficit** is the estimated number of COVID-19 vaccinations that may not be administered in each U.S. county based on previous annual influenza vaccination rates. A 70% vaccination rate is the minimum necessary to achieve “herd immunity.”

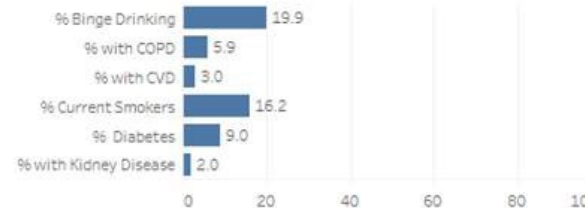
