## Dear Leader Schumer and Speaker Pelosi:

On behalf of America's families, the undersigned organizations extend our deepest appreciation to the House of Representatives for passage of the Build Back Better Act. This landmark legislation will drastically improve affordability and expand access to health coverage, reduce racial health inequities, and transform the lives of millions of America's families.

The Build Back Better Act advances policies our communities have spent years – sometimes decades – fiercely advocating for, including:

- Closing the Medicaid coverage gap that that will lead to 2.2 million uninsured people, a majority of whom are people of color, gaining coverage;
- Allowing Medicare to negotiate for fair drug prices and lowering prescription drug costs;
- Making Marketplace coverage more affordable through meaningful premium reductions for lower income individuals, many of whom are people of color;
- 12 months of continuous eligibility in Medicaid and CHIP; making federal CHIP funding permanent, investments in the perinatal workforce, health coverage of people transitioning out of incarceration, and funding for consumer assistance programs;
- Making crucial investments to address pervasive maternal health inequities by extending
  pregnancy-related Medicaid and CHIP eligibility to 12 months after pregnancy in every state and
  including key pieces of the groundbreaking Black Maternal Health Momnibus Act, which
  together represent an historic investment to target racial health disparities and advance birth
  equity;
- Providing high quality care for older individuals and people with disabilities in their homes and communities;
- Ensuring workers have four weeks of paid family and medical leave;
- Expanding Medicare to cover hearing services and hearing aids; and,
- Investing in critical programs that address social drivers of health such as nutrition, education, housing, child care, and climate change.

We applaud the House for putting forward a robust package, and believe all of its components must remain intact through enactment. That is why we urge the Senate not to delay in passing this bill and to send it to the President's desk for his immediate signature.

Our organizations are in your corner to ensure passage of the Build Back Better Act, and stand ready to support the Administration in its implementation. There's not a moment to waste in making these policies a reality and to jumpstart our just recovery to truly "build back better."
