




What is the AAFP Credit System?

- Only the AAFP has authority over the AAFP Credit System



Create account

-One time process

Apply online and pay review fee

- -30-60 minutes to complete
- -Worksheets available

Receive credit determination letter

- -No later than 20 business days after payment is received
- -Website listing in CME Search
