The purpose of this position is to advocate for AAFP policy and values in the AMA-MSS congress and report to the AAFP on new developments in the AMA-MSS.

Any Subcommittee Work

The AMA-MSS asked the AMA HOD to support the enforcement of proposed federal accessibility standards for medical diagnostic equipment, as well as tax incentives and deductions that help physicians implement these standards.

Additionally the AMA-MSS asked the AMA HOD to support mifepristone availability for reproductive health indications, including via telemedicine, telehealth, and at retail pharmacies.

During this conference I made valuable connections and met many members of the community of Family physicians interested in advocacy and policy work with the AMA. I saw firsthand the values of the AMA and the work they are doing, while comparing them to the values of the AAFP.
