

Summary of Findings – Practice Models

Direct Primary Care (DPC)




Figure 36. Awareness of the direct primary care (DPC) model of practice (not queried before 2013).

With regard to awareness of the DPC model of practice (see Table 42 and Figure 36):

- Most (58%) are unfamiliar with the term *direct primary care*
- One third (33%) have heard of DPC but are only beginning to learn about the model
- Only one in 10 understand the DPC model (2% work in a DPC practice, 1% work in a practice transforming to a DPC model, and 7% work in a practice considering the DPC model).
