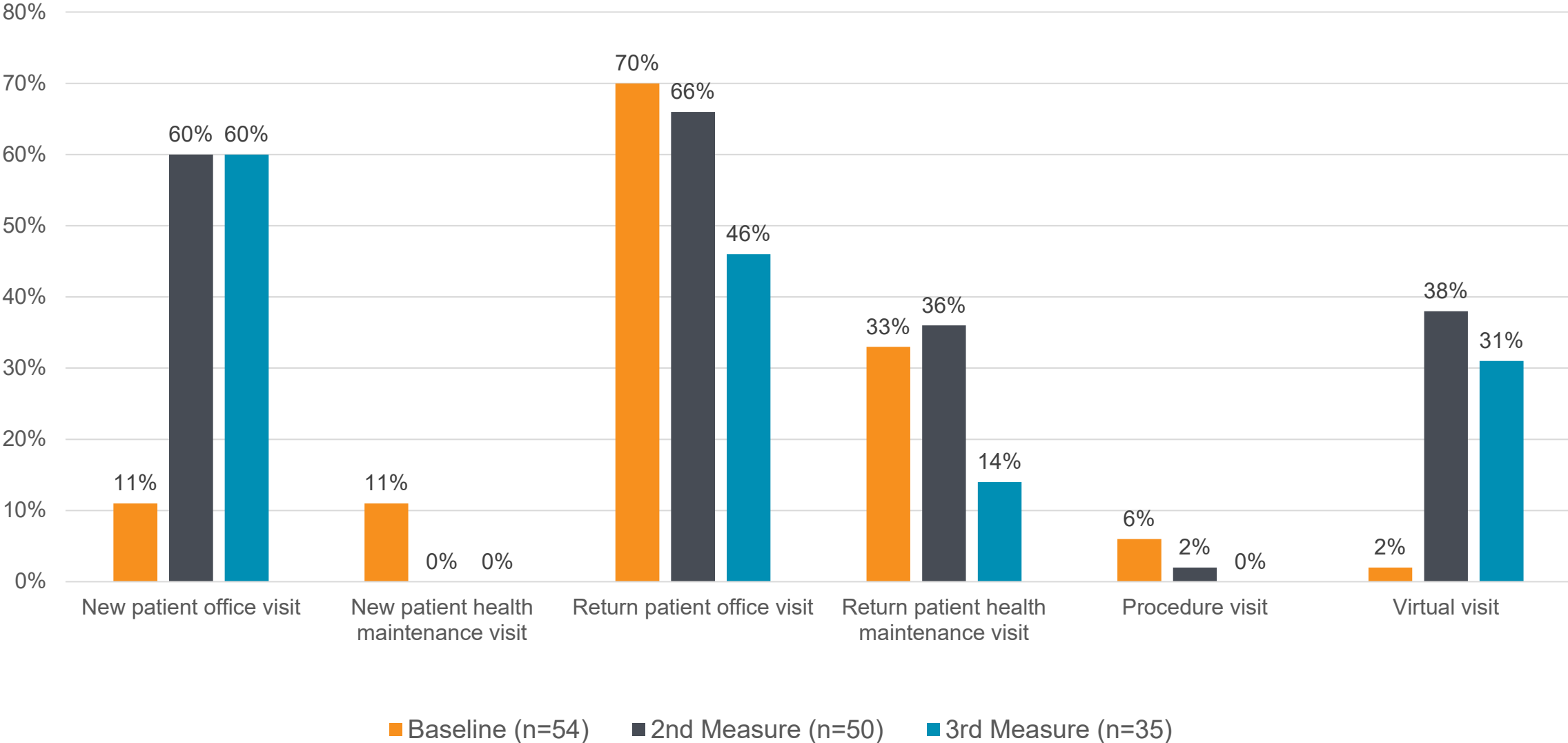

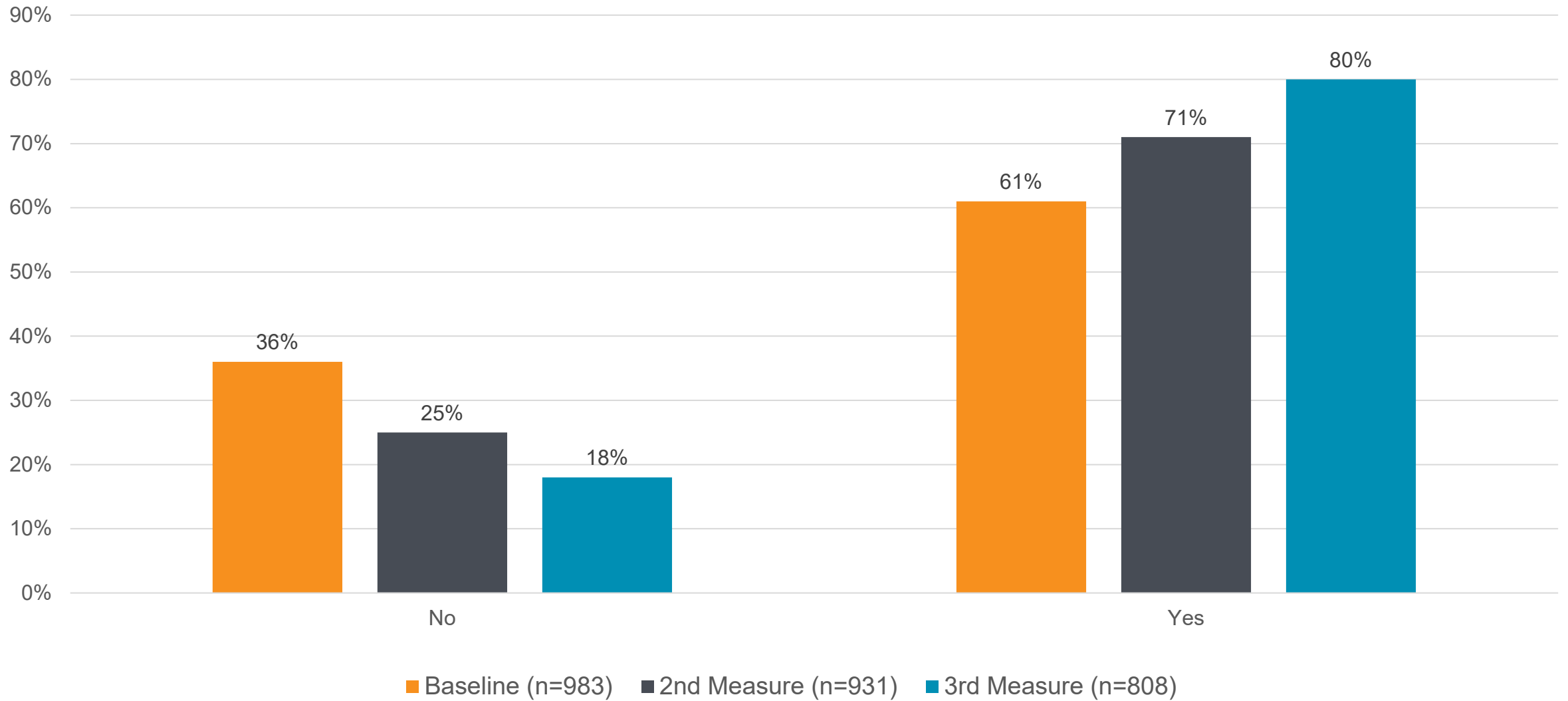

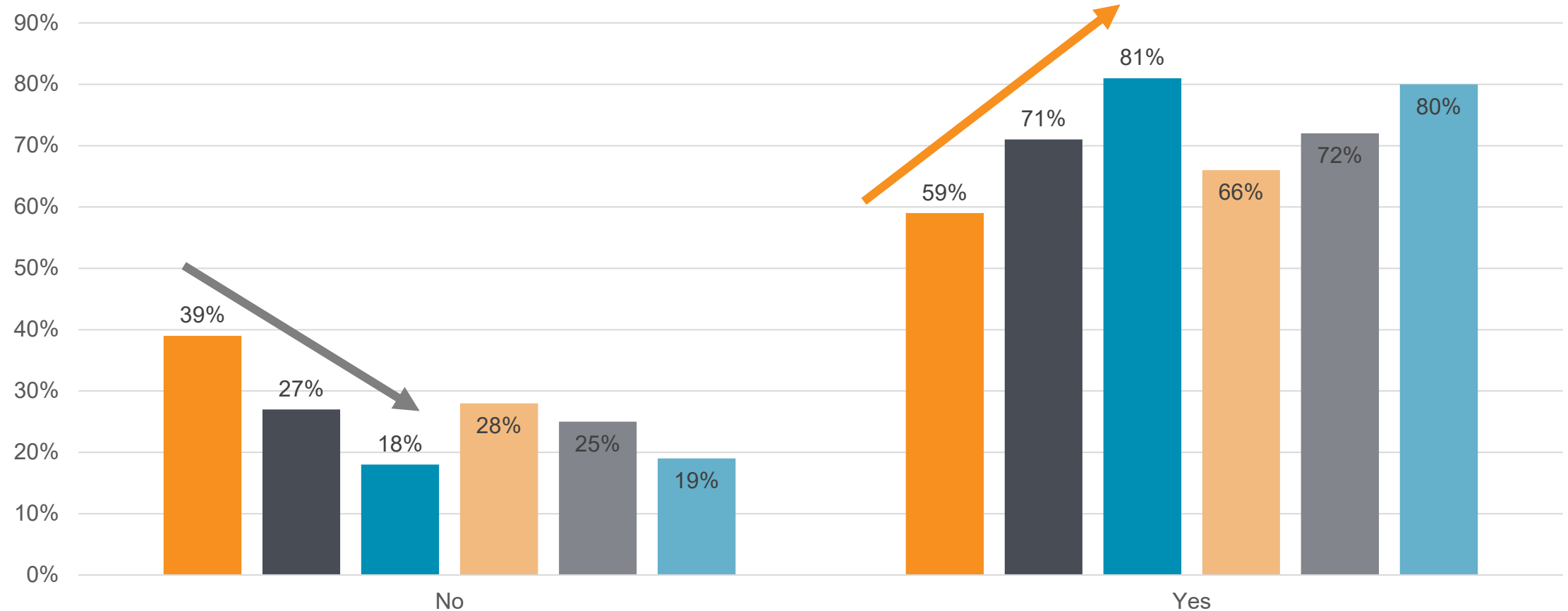
Patients trying to become pregnant: High risk

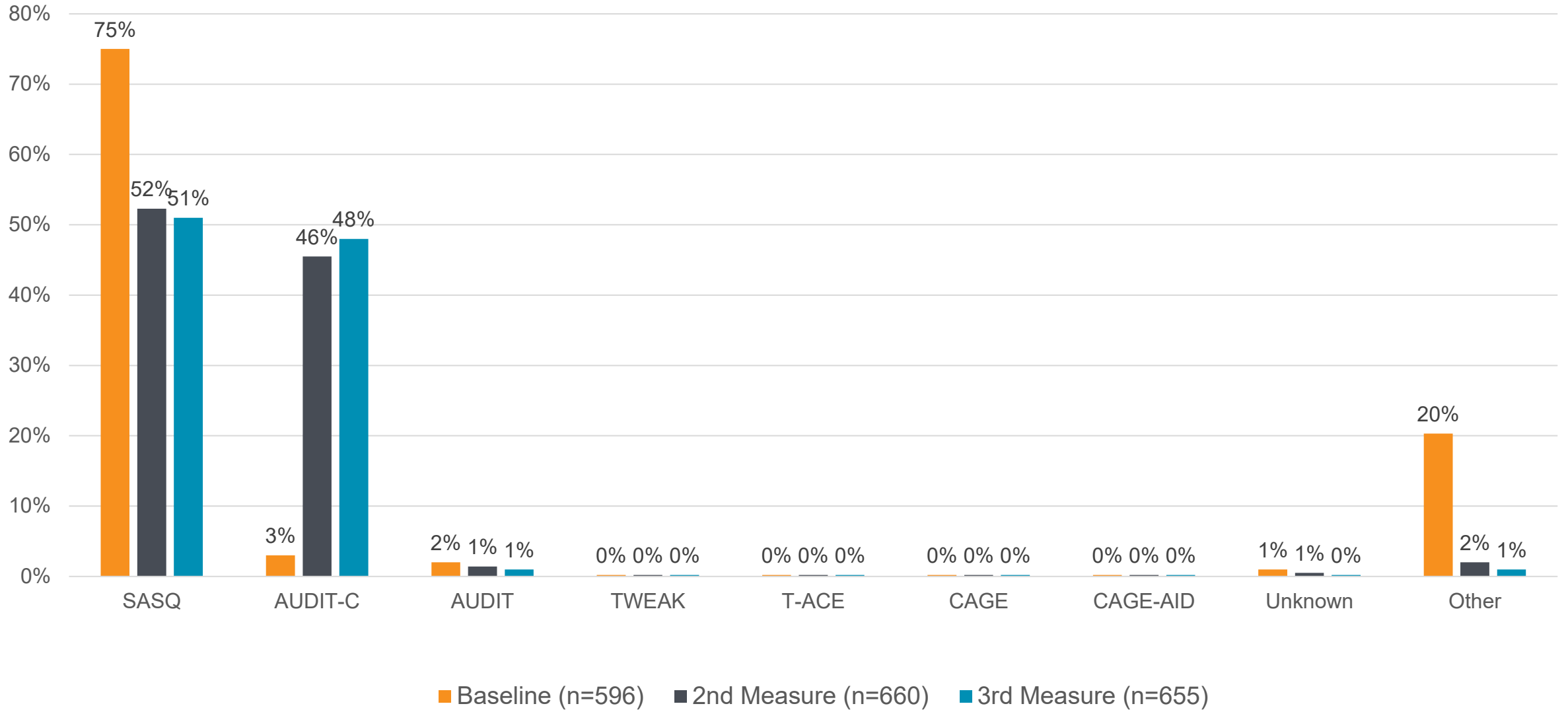

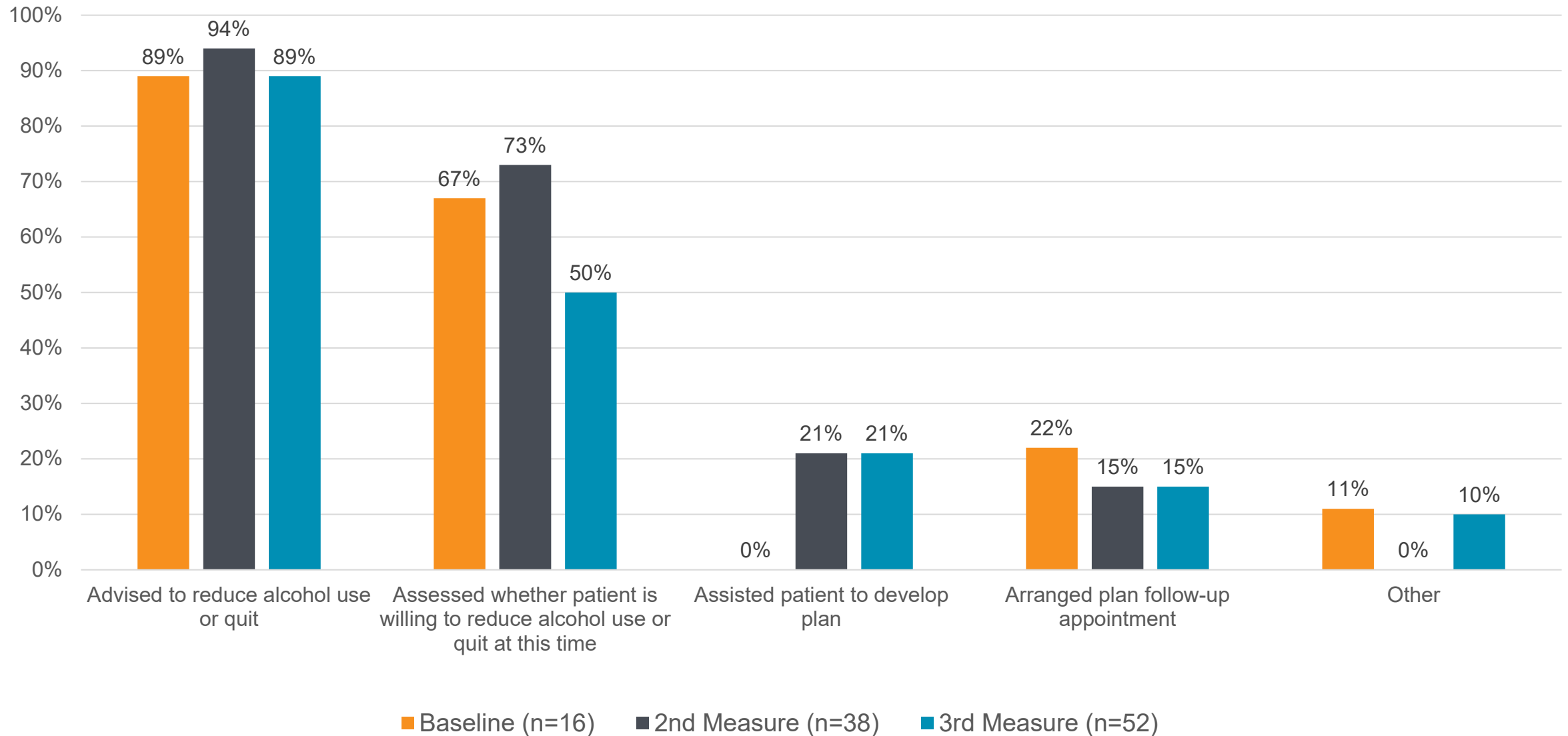
What type of intervention was provided?



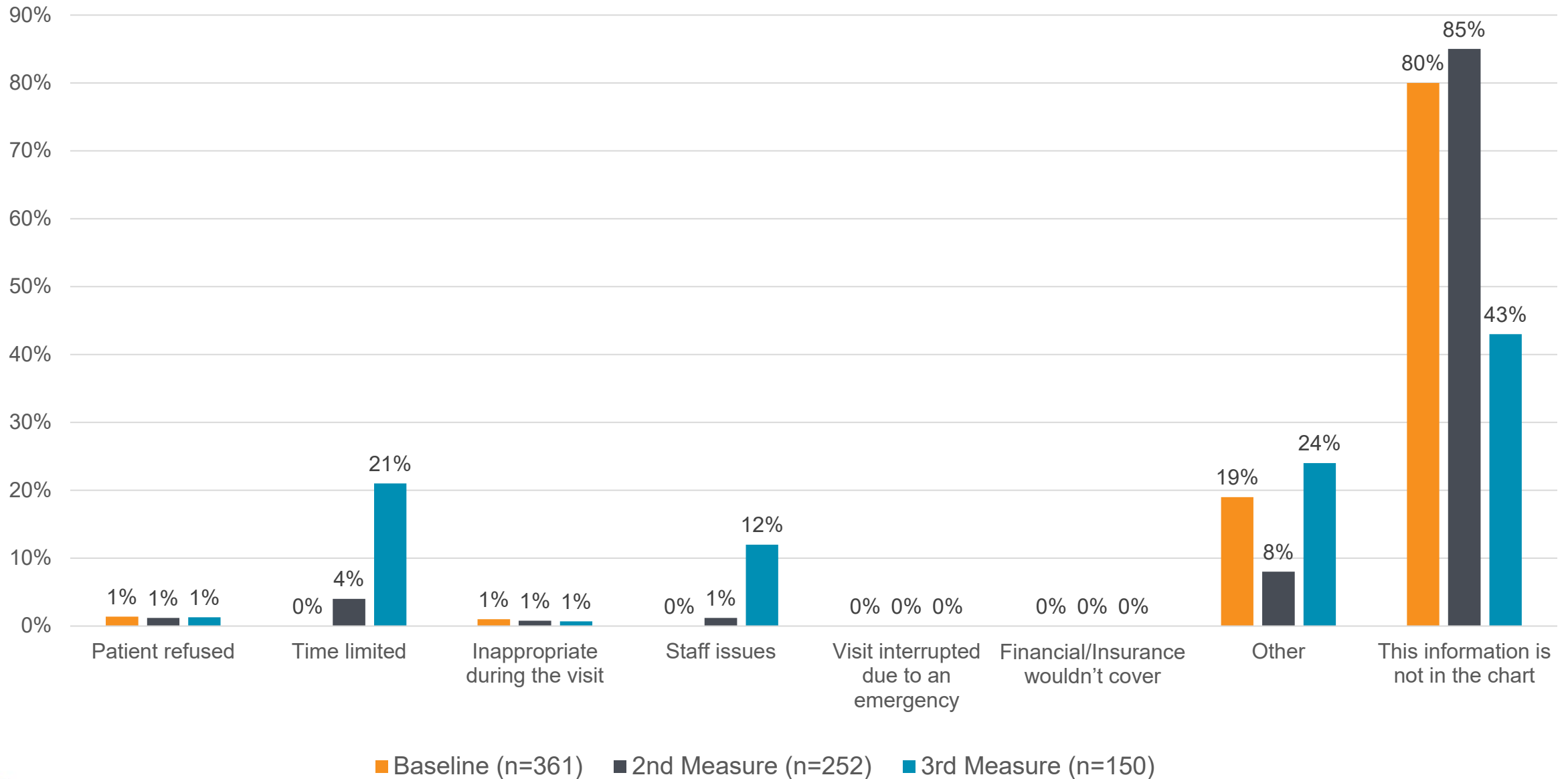
Where or to whom was patient referred?



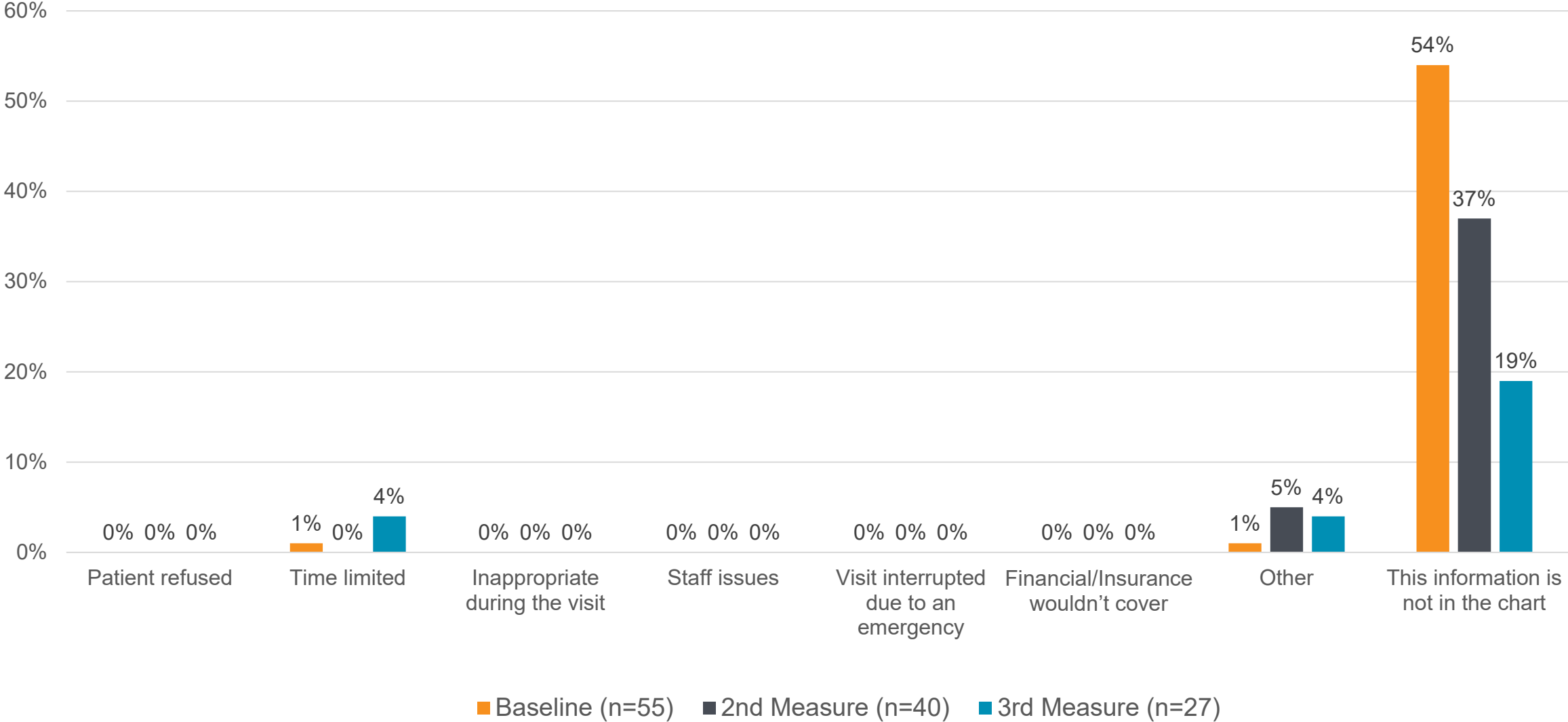
Components included in brief intervention



Why was patient not screened?



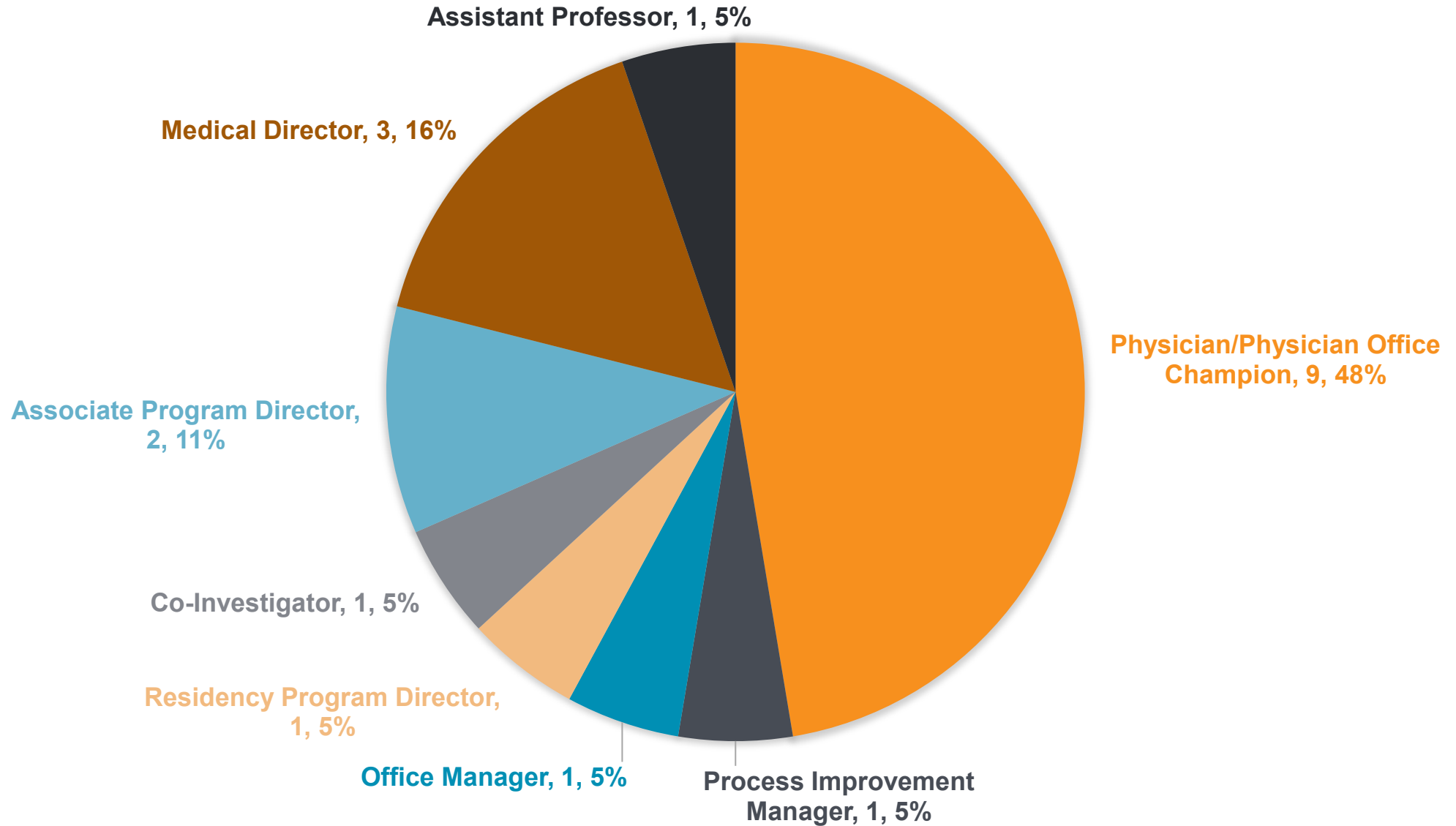

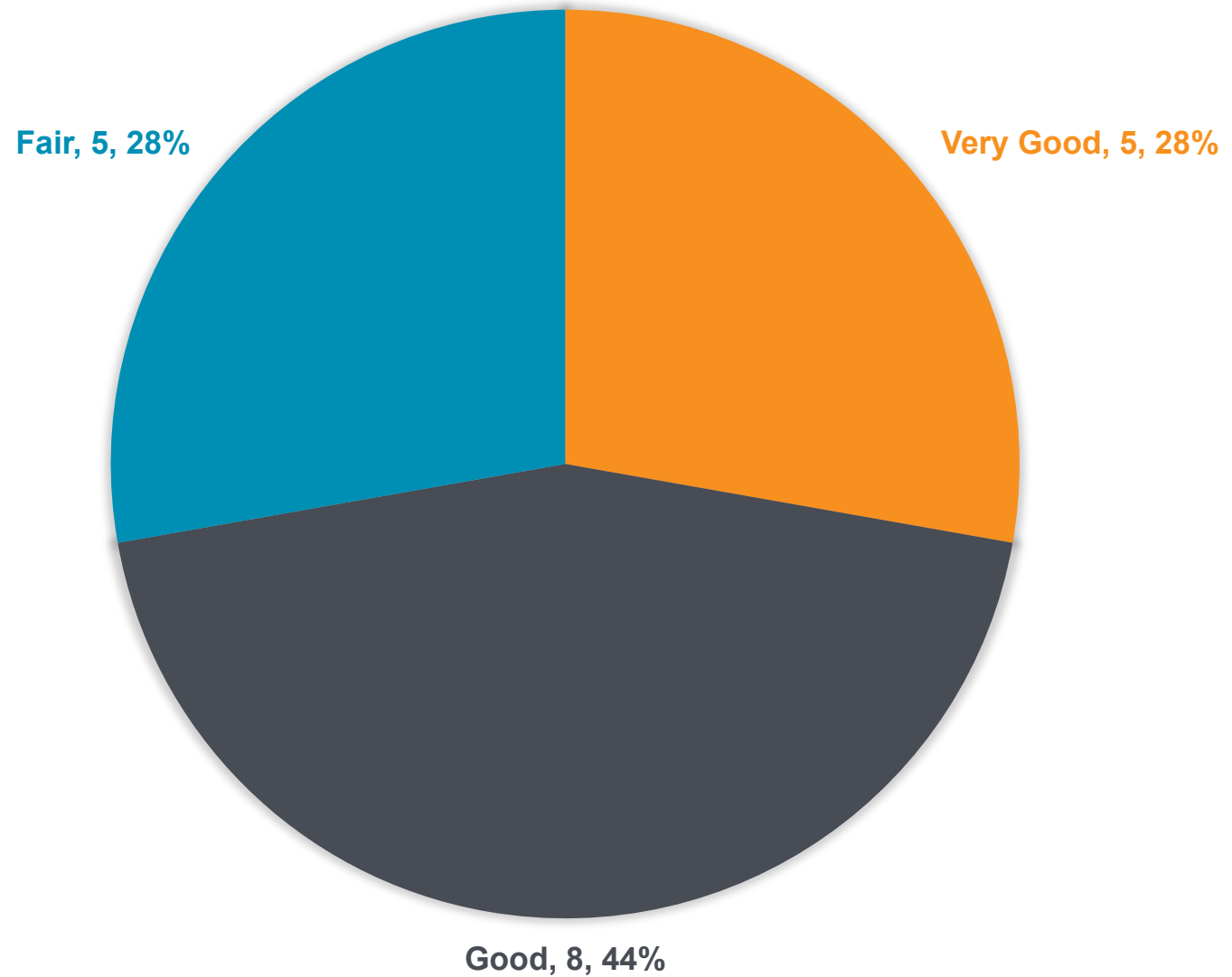


There are clear clinical alcohol screening workflow processes and responsibilities, and the work is shared across the team and does not rely on individuals.

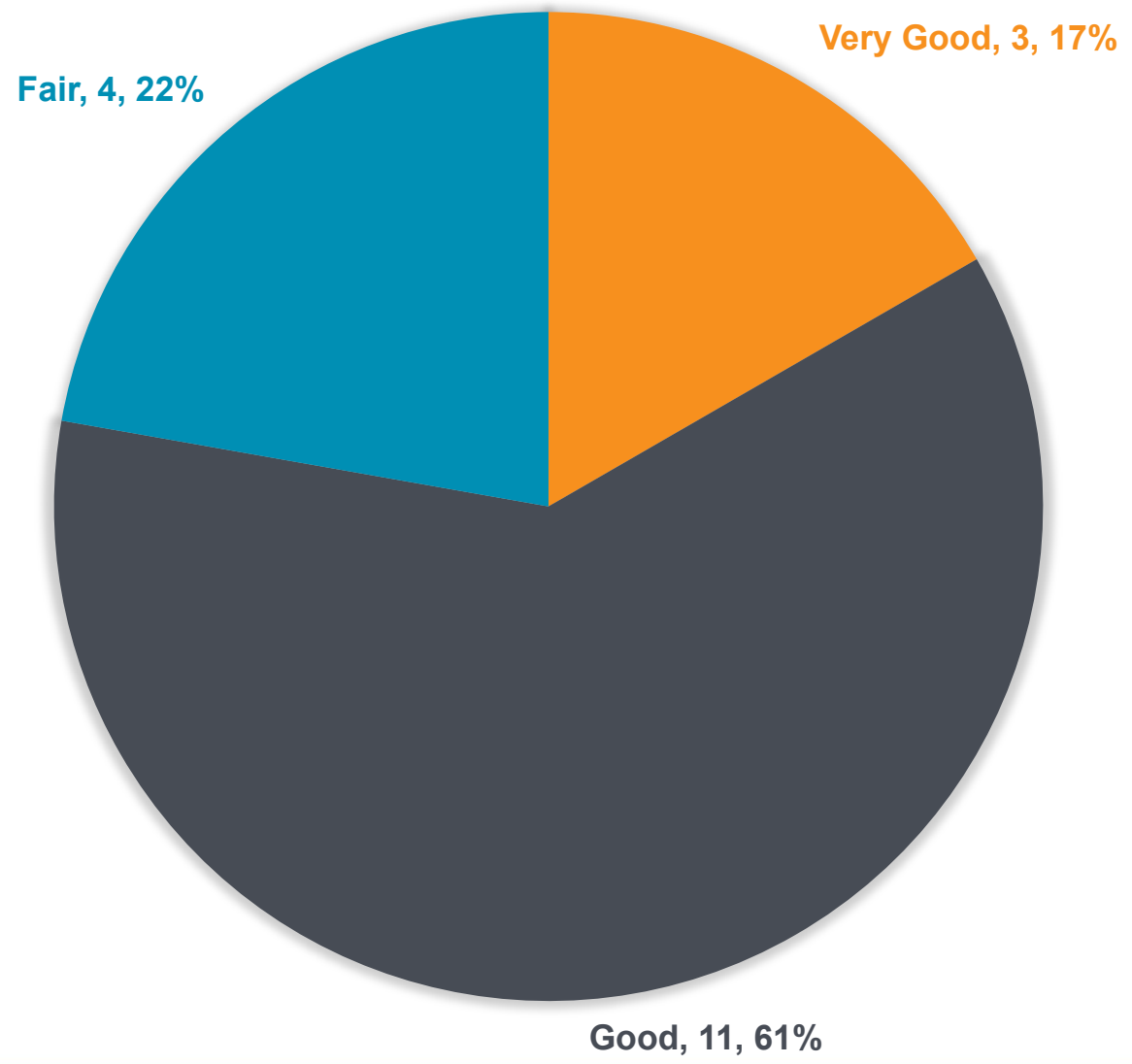


There is a monitoring system to collect, manage, and regularly review data. Feedback is shared with me, clinical staff, and leadership on a regular basis.

There is evidence of benefits of the program emerging.

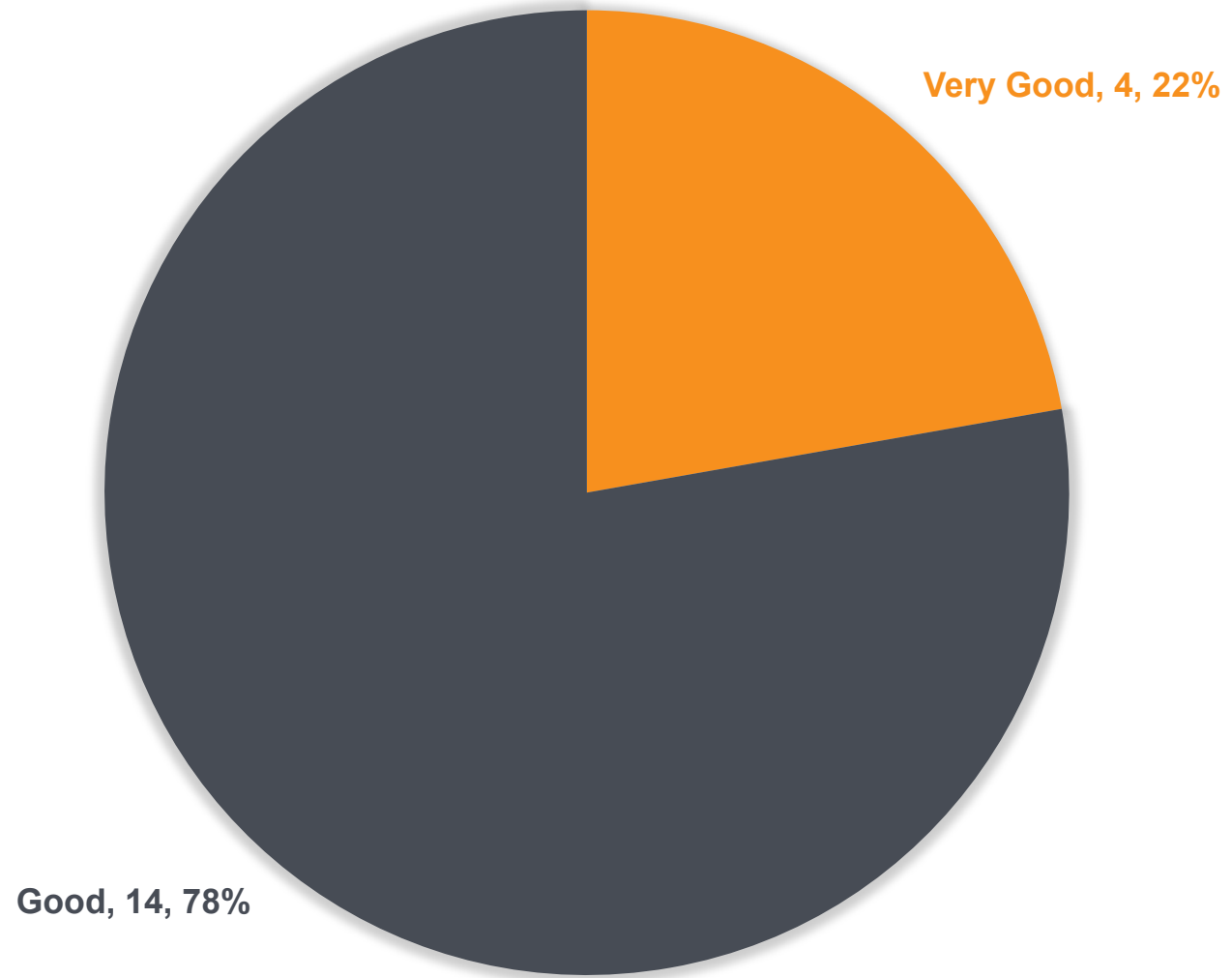


There is opportunity to adapt the program to reflect local needs, changing settings, and priorities.

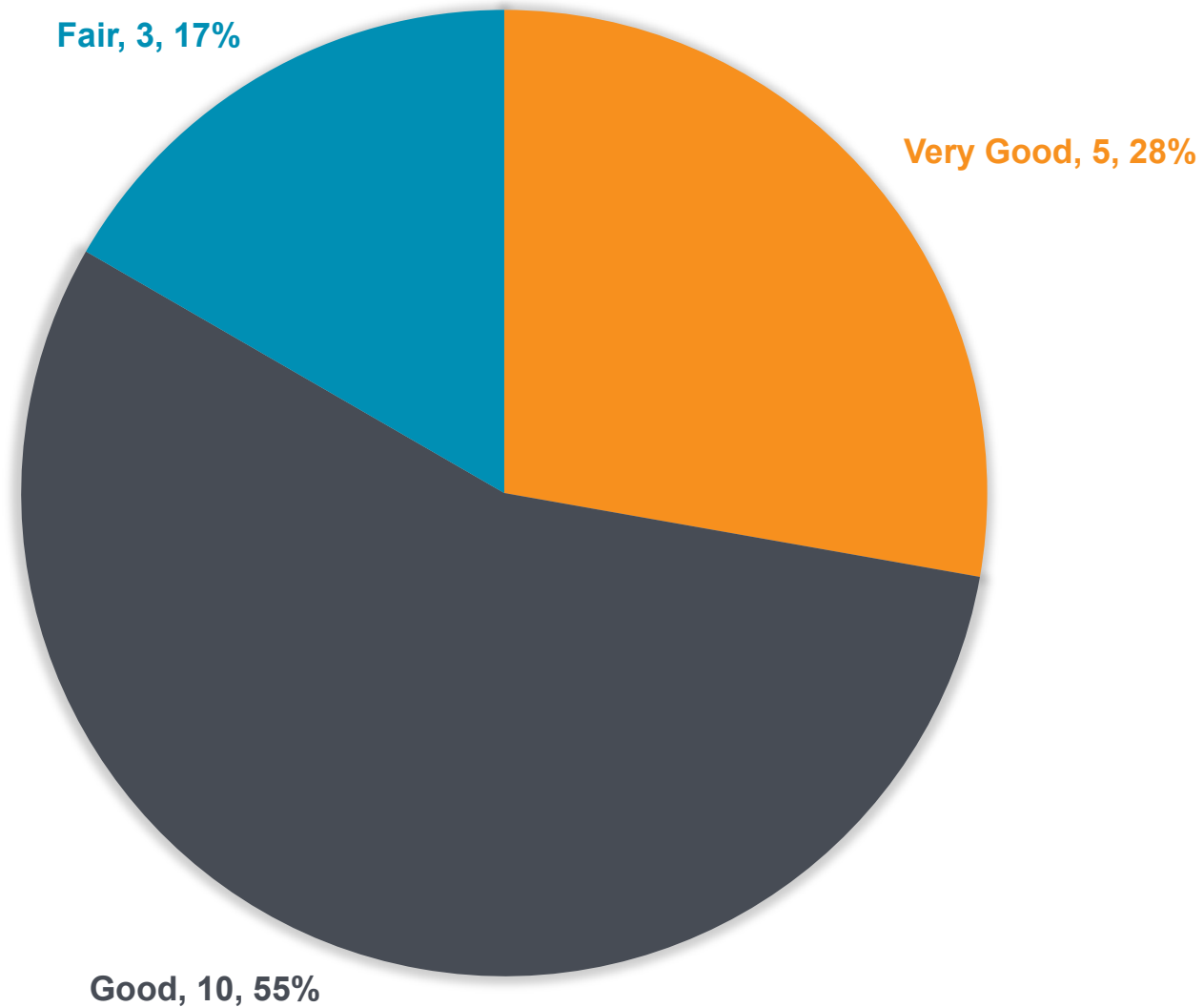




The program is aligned with the strategic aims and priorities of the organization.
