New Strategic Plan

The AAFP Foundation Board of Trustees approved a new three-year strategic plan at the November 2017 Board meeting. This new strategic plan, which will take effect in January will focus the Foundation's work in three primary areas:

Focus — On initiatives that elevate awareness, create sustainability, and are reflective of our mission.

Growth — In effectively developing new and innovative opportunities to increase donors, financial support, and volunteer base.

Alignment — By seeking stronger and more effective collaboration that supports and enhances our mission.

In addition, the AAFP Foundation will continue to emphasize signature programs in three major areas, Humanitarian, Education and Scientific through Family Medicine Cares, Family Medicine Leads and a yet to be named Scientific initiative.

Disaster Assistance

Given the significant natural disasters that have affected Texas, Florida and the Caribbean this year, the AAFP Foundation has been extremely active in providing financial support to the affected areas. The AAFP Foundation raised more than \$125,000 primarily from AAFP member contributions, which has been distributed to all affected areas. The AAFP Foundation works directly with two disaster relief partners, Heart to Heart International and International Medical Corp who have, and continue to be extremely active in all three areas. The AAFP Foundation has also provided more than \$20,000 directly to the Puerto Rico AAFP Chapter and its members to assist with the purchase of generators and structural repair.
